

SICILIAN FIELD-TRIP 2009

Dear friends,

after the last field-trip in Sardinia (2008), now we want to explore **Sicily**, in order to get information on the distribution of its species, and especially we want to look for *Zygonyx torridus*, *Trithemis kirbyi* and other species that might be present in such a beautiful island.

The field-trip will be held from the **8th to the 14th of June 2009**, and, in order to explore the island as much as possible, we'll have stay in two different accommodations, one in the northern and one in the southern part of the island.

From the 8th to the 11th morning

From the 11th evening to the 14th

B&B il Carubo

(in Acate, Vittoria, with five rooms and 12 beds. 35 euros for sleeping and breakfast.)

Both places will give us also the possibility to camp, if there's not enough place for everyone in the rooms, at a lower price (of course, including breakfast).

- by plane, lots of low cost companies fly to Palermo, Catania or Trapani
- by ferry-boat, from Genua or Rome
